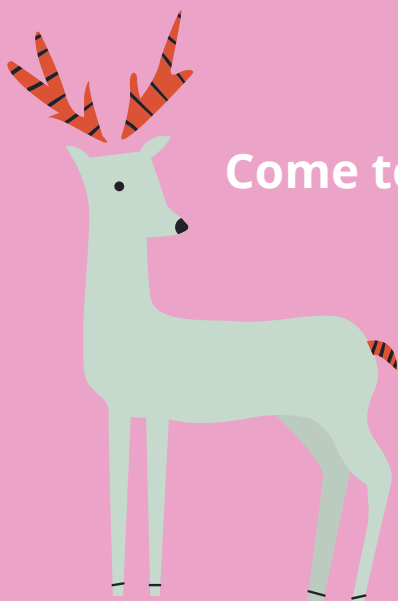

GRAHAM CRACKER TOFFEE



- 14-16 sheets of graham crackers
- 1 cup packed brown sugar
- 1 cup (2 sticks) salted butter
- 1 cup mini semisweet chocolate chips
- 1 cup chopped pecans, toasted

Pre-heat oven to 350 degrees, place one layer of graham crackers on greased cookie sheet with layer of chocolate chips on top. Melt butter & brown sugar and pour over top, bake for 5-7 minutes & top with nuts!
